British Chess Magazine is the world's oldest chess journal in continuous publication. The German player Fritz Baumbach was the world correspondence chess champion from 1905 to 1910, so this may have influenced the naming. He is one of England's strongest chess players and was formerly in the world's top ten. In chess, he was twice British chess champion and earned the title of International Master. He was tipped to reach the heights scaled by other leading English players as Michael Adams and Nigel Short but made the decision to cease playing professionally in his mid 20s, opting for an IT career in the Netherlands. Together with Timothy Whitworth, he published a selection of his best endgame studies, entitled *The Best of Bent*.
