It is recommended that large trees greater than 3 in 75 mm be used very sparingly if at all. Plants must be adapted to the climate of the area and to the unique environment. Invasive species of plants as listed by the California Invasive Plant Council should be avoided especially near parks, buffers, greenbelts, water bodies, and open spaces because of their potential to cause harm to sensitive areas.
